




Marina di Valletta is set just below the majestic and recently restored historic Valletta fortifications, which overlook the marina in all their splendour.



## Mature

Malta has plenty of natural attractions, a great balance of nature, adventure and fascinating scenery. You would be amazed how a small island in the Mediterranean like this can hold space for such spectacular sights of nature. Just to name a few, Malta's very first marine park lying on the Northwest point of the island, the irkewwa Marine Park, or The Majjistral Nature and History Park, situated on the Northwest coast of Malta. The park includes 6 kilometers of walkable coastline, where you can admire cliffs and valleys with far-reaching views of the sister island, Gozo. The breathtaking Dingli Cliffs, the highest landmass in Malta with multiple caves all throughout these limestone rock cliffs, could be easily seen from the western side of the island.







## i MUST-SEE

Valletta, The Fortress City, Citta' Umilissima, "a city built by gentlemen for gentlemen" is Malta's capital city: a living, working city, the administrative and commercial heart of the Islands. Valletta is named after its founder, the respected Grand Master of the Order of St. John, Jean Parisot de la Valette. The magnificent fortress city grew on the arid rock of Mount Sceberras peninsula, which rises steeply from two deep harbours, Marsamxett and Grand Harbour.

## Culture

The Entire City Of Valletta Is A UNESCO World Heritage Site. Today, the Renaissance city, with its auberges, palaces and fortifications, bears testimony to a bygone time. Alongside contemporary life, the city verily showcases 450 years of history on every street.

Started in 1566, Valletta was completed, with its impressive bastions, forts and cathedral, in the astonishingly short time of 15 years, even more remarkable is considering the fact that mechanical tools did not exist at the time and the whole city was built entirely by hand.

Whether you're interested in history, adrenaline sports or night life or simply wish to be bowled over by natural splendour, the list of things to do in Malta is endless.

Hometosome of the oldest free-standing temples in the World, the Islands have also played host to the Phoenicians, the Romans, the Knights of St. John, Napoleon and the British Empire. 


