

YARD

Rules

1

Please follow health and safety rules before carrying out any kind of work on the boat.

2

Please ensure that you do not cause damages & disturb other boats and people while carrying out maintenance works.

3

Do not remove cradles, supports, planks and wooden blocks. Contact the marina's office and/or person in charge if there is such request.

4

Ensure that area exposed to wind on deck is kept to a minimum. Place jibs on the deck to prevent vibration, remove sails or similar equipment.

5

It is not allowed to start the boat's engine(s) as well as to open the sail(s) while the boat remains on the land.

6

Please ensure that climbing ladders and scaffolders are properly secured before being used.

7

Shore power should be connected to the boat only while she is attended by the owner or his representative.

8

Please ensure that electrical hand tools and all electric cables are in conformity with health and safety rules and managed in a secure manner.

9

Be aware of objects that may fall off from the boats within the shipyard.

10

It is not allowed for any materials or objects to be placed under the boat and/or at any other area of the dry docking without the Marina's permission.

11

Parking of cars or any other transportation mean under/by the boat is PROHIBITED.

12

Please do not spread paint, etc. on cradles, supports, planks or ground.

13

For collecting or/and emptying bilges, sludge and sewage tank before drydock operations, please contact Marina's Office.

14

Please pay attention to environmental practices applied in this marina.

15

Please return borrowed extension electric cables, ladders and steps provided by the marina to the person in charge before launching your boat.

16

Before launching the boat, please store fenders and ropes appropriately and remove locked ladders or landings.

17

Please do not set sails until your boat is launched and until the travel lift is clear from the dock.

18

Staying on board during lifting, moving & launching is STRICTLY PROHIBITED.

19

Living on board is PROHIBITED.

20

The entrance and stay of non-authorized personnel into the dry dock area is STRICTLY PROHIBITED. The authorized personnel are allowed to remain and work only during the assigned hours.
